

10. The fixation of annual rate of interest payable to the members of the Fund by the Board in consultation with the Government.
11. The form in which the employees shall furnish particulars of himself and his family.
12. The nomination of any person or persons to receive the amount at the credit of a member on his death and the cancellation or alteration of such nomination.
13. Registers and records to be maintained by the employers and the returns to be furnished by them.
14. The powers, if any, which may be exercised by the officers appointed under this Act for the administration of the Scheme.
15. The conditions of service, duties and remuneration of officers working under the Board.
16. Any other matter which is to be provided for in the Scheme for the purpose of implementing the Scheme.

THE KERALA GENERAL SALES TAX (SECOND AMENDMENT)  
ACT, 1974\*

(ACT 19 OF 1974)

*An Act further to amend the Kerala General Sales Tax Act, 1963*

*Preamble.*—WHEREAS it is expedient further to amend the Kerala General Sales Tax Act, 1963, for the purposes hereinafter appearing;

\* Received the assent of the Governor on the 31st day of October, 1974 and published in the Gazette Extraordinary No. 754 dated 1st November, 1974.

BE it enacted in the Twenty-fifth Year of the Republic of India as follows:—

1. *Short title and commencement.*—(1) This Act may be called the Kerala General Sales Tax (Second Amendment) Act, 1974.

(2) It shall be deemed to have come into force on the 15th day of May, 1974.

2. *Amendment of section 5.*—In section 5 of the Kerala General Sales Tax Act, 1963 (15 of 1963) (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act),—

(i) in sub-section (1),—

(a) in clause (ii), for the words "three and a half per cent", the words "four per cent" shall be substituted;

(b) the proviso shall be omitted;

(ii) in sub-section (4), for the words "three and a half per cent", the words "four per cent" shall be substituted.

3. *Repeal and saving.*—(1) The Kerala General Sales Tax (Second Amendment) Ordinance, 1974 (2 of 1974), is hereby repealed.

(2) Notwithstanding such repeal, anything done or any action taken under the principal Act as amended by the said Ordinance shall be deemed to have been done or taken under the principal Act as amended by this Act.
